Following three weekends of demolition work, Insite Construction have been onsite daily, clearing out excess fill in preparation for the construction of the building. In short, they are 'digging down, and will then build up'. The hole in the ground is quite impressive, and the children have enjoyed watching a multitude of trucks come and go on a daily basis, removing the excess dirt. This hole is allowing for the three levels of administration to be constructed from the level of the Upper Quad. This will allow the children access to the new Library, directly from the play-space on the Upper Quad.



Insite plan to have all digging completed by the end of business tomorrow, allowing for plumbing to begin early next week.
