SCHOOL TUITION FEES. (Charged per student) the fee is based on the number of students per family and is set annually in consultation with the Parish Priest, School Board, Parish Finance Council and School Principal, as part of the process of setting a yearly school budget.

The tuition fees assist in paying for the following:

- Archdiocesan Educational Levy (forwarded to Brisbane Catholic Education to supplement State and Commonwealth grants and assists in the payment of salaries and centrally provided services).
- Administration costs e.g. stationery, postage, phone, etc
- Teaching/learning resources including classroom, first aid, library
- Utility costs e.g. Electricity, rates, insurance
- Furniture and equipment
- Building and equipment maintenance, security
- Supplementary staffing (as required)
- Specialist teacher salaries [Art, Music & Physical Education]

SCHOOL LEVIES:¹ (*Charged per student*) This levy allows us to budget for and provide:

- Classroom resources and consumable materials
- Photocopying and printing
- Swimming, Dance Fever, Excursions, P.E. resources, Sports and Curriculum activities and additional Activities transport costs.

IT LEVY: After consultation with our parent community throughout 2018, this is a new, stand alone, levy commencing in 2019. In the lower years (Prep-3) this levy will cover the purchase of additional IT resources (software and hardware), maintenance of existing equipment and associated costs in this area. In Year 4, the additional funding will be used to purchase iPads as part of our 1:1 iPad program, beginning in Year 4. Year 5/6 will continue the Bring Your Own Device (BYOD) 1:1 program.

CAPITAL LEVY: (*Charged per family*) The Capital Levy enables us to pay our school building loans as well as provide additional facilities for the students. It is also used to provide the necessary maintenance, cleaning and improvements needed for the building and grounds of our school.

VOLUNTARY BUILDING LEVY: (*Charged per family*) We ask that each family makes a building fund contribution of \$200 per year. This donation is fully tax deductible and forms a very important part of our funding to assist the construction of new facilities and buildings to meet the needs of our community now and into the future.

P&F LEVY: (*Charged per family*) This levy is collected on behalf of the P&F. Funds raised go towards: Classroom resources, maintenance and special projects.
