St Ollie's Building Update

19th February 2021

If you have been watching the progress of the new build from Beauvardia St, you would now see that we have a middle floor, and ceiling for our bottom level Library. Our students, particularly the Year 3 students, have been watching the building move quite quickly from a single level, to now a dual level building, following the ground floor slab concrete pour three weeks ago.



The weather does, however, continue to create barriers for our builders, as they are attempting to make up time for the delayed slab pour as a result of Christmas rain and the lockdown in January. Regardless of the weather this week, InSite have been working to ensure that the second slab pour, which will become the floor of the Administration first floor, continues to go ahead, as soon as possible. This afternoon, InSite have confirmed that the building is ready for this concrete pour, which will occur from 6.30am on **Monday 22nd February – this coming Monday morning.**

Monday's concrete pour is slightly more problematic than the one we had three weeks ago. Our school community will need to make the following allowances on Monday morning at Drop-Off time, as a result of the cement trucks being onsite from 6.30am. These allowances are only relevant for morning

Drop-off on Monday 22nd February. The concrete pour will be completed and changes to traffic conditions will no longer be a concern by Monday afternoon.

Beauvardia St Drop-Off Zone

- Beauvardia St will have traffic controllers onsite to support vehicles travelling in both directions.
- The school Drop-off Zone in Beauvardia St will be open and supervised by school staff on Monday morning, however, due to the limitations of the traffic flow in Beauvardia St, there will be delays in vehicles being able to access this zone. Traffic controllers onsite will be directing cars to the zone – please be patient if you intend to use Beauvardia St to drop students off.
- Students who walk to school, from Stanton St and into Beauvardia St, will be escorted into the school grounds via the Church Driveway by school staff.
- Students who walk to school, from Molloy Rd and into Beauvardia St will continue to be able to use the bottom gate on Beauvardia St to enter the school grounds.

Camelia St Drop-Off Zone

- Camelia St will have no changes made to traffic flow, however, please be aware that there may be additional vehicles using this Drop-Off Zone as a result of the changed traffic conditions on Beauvardia St.
- Additional staff will be supporting students exiting cars on Camelia St to ease increased traffic in this Drop-off zone.
